This has been a magnificent year for the Rickmansworth GC seniors with the winning of the '4 clubs' trophy and retaining the Haste Hill Shield and the Holden-Mallick trophy against the Rickmansworth Ladies. The team played 14 matches and won 9 of them. This compares favourably with last year's results.

We won the '4 clubs' with 8 points against Shendish Manor and Batchwood both on 5. The Haste Hill Shield was a tighter match than last year and was again played at the South Buckinghamshire Golf Club but still managed a win of 3.5 vs 2.5.

29 different players took part in these competitions 4 less than last year and had 5 debutants, namely Darryl Nunn, Ian Hills, Leon Kelly and Paul Roffe. They all performed well, winning most if not all their matches.

Ian Brown and Vic Meakes played in 12 games out of the 17 with Frank Haines playing 11 and new boy Darryl Nunn and Tom Moore playing 10 times.

Like last year the 'Player of the Year' goes to the person who has the highest win ratio after playing in more than 5 matches. Steve Browning was the winner with a percentage of 88%, meaning he won 7 of the 8 times he played.

I would like to thank the stand in Captains Bob Horton, Darryl Nunn and of course Frank Haines (who did have a 73% win ratio).
